

## Gift Aid Declaration

for past, present and future donations

### Boost your donation by 25p of Gift Aid for every £1 you donate

Gift Aid is reclaimed by UK for UNHCR from the tax you pay for the current tax year. Your address is needed to identify you as a current UK taxpayer.

In order to Gift Aid your donation you must tick the box below:

I understand that other taxes such as VAT and Council Tax do not qualify.
